FLORIDA COMMISSION ON OFFENDER REVIEW TO HOLD HEARINGS IN FORT LAUDERDALE

TALLAHASSEE, FLA – On Wednesday, February 12 and Thursday, February 13, 2020, the Florida Commission on Offender Review will hold Commission hearings at the Fort Lauderdale City Hall located at 100 N. Andrews Ave, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301. Hearings are scheduled to begin promptly at 9 A.M., EST and are open to the public.

Florida law requires the Commission to hold hearings around the state at locations where parole eligible inmates committed their offenses to facilitate the ability of victims and other interested parties to attend Commission hearings.

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The Florida Commission on Offender Review (FCOR), is a constitutionally authorized, quasi-judicial, decision-making body which has been serving the citizens of this state since 1941. The Commission holds offenders accountable for their behaviors and ensures public safety through its careful selection of offenders for re-entry into society by administering parole, conditional medical release, control release, conditional release, and addiction recovery release supervision. The Commission also acts as the investigative arm of the Governor and Cabinet, sitting as the Board of Executive Clemency in clemency matters. The Commission's mission is to ensure public safety and provide victim assistance through the post prison release process.
